Thank you for your interest in becoming a Boston Harbor Pilot. We are now taking applications from eligible candidates. Applications may be obtained at the Pilot Commissioners' website ([www.masspilotage.com](http://www.masspilotage.com)) or by writing to the office of the Pilot Commissioners at: Pilot Commissioners, 100 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, Suite 102, Boston, MA 02129 All applications and supporting documents must be submitted to Pilot Commissioners' Office by the end of business on March 31, 2023. The selected candidate will start training on or about July 1, 2023. All dates are subject to change. Applications may be submitted via email at [pilotcommissioners1@comcast.net](mailto:pilotcommissioners1@comcast.net) or via mail to Pilot Commissioners' Office at above address.

The following documentation is required to be submitted to the Pilot Commissioners:

- Application (Form D1-001a)
- Documentary proof candidate is 21 years of age or older
- Documentary proof candidate is a citizen of the United States
- Documentary proof candidate has successfully completed 12 years of formal education or the equivalent
- Your last physical examination that meets the license requirements of the U.S. Coast Guard
- Documentary proof candidate has satisfactory maritime experience as required by 995 CMR 2.10
- Documentary proof candidate has current and unrestricted Merchant Marine Credentials as required by 995 CMR 2.12(a)
- Application fee of \$500.00 made to the Commissioners of Pilots, District 1
- Proof of residency in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
